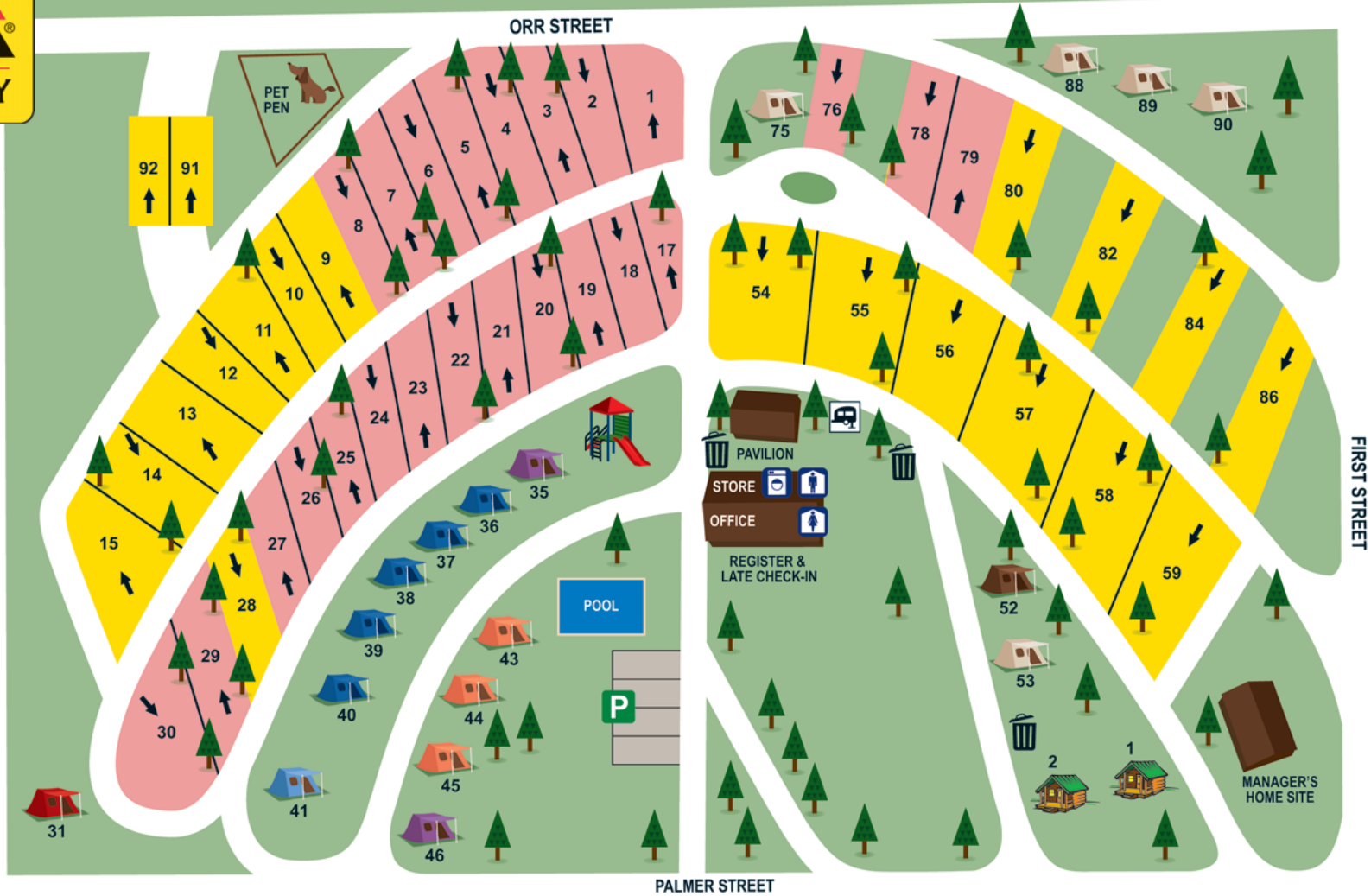

## Campground Guidelines

- 1 We'd love for you to stay another night, yet all good things must end. So, we've established 11:00 AM as the check-out time, along with our 1:00 pm check-in.
- 2 Please display the fashionable yellow car pass in your window. If you have visitors, they also must register at the office and display their car pass.
- 3 This is a family-friendly park, so please respect the oh-so-quiet hours of 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. No generators are to be used within the campground.
- 4 We really don't own all surrounding property you see, so please respect the property surrounding the park.
- 5 We all love the pool. But, nothing dampens that more than a baby without a swim diaper. Footwear is required when entering or leaving the pool area. Please remember, there is no lifeguard.
- 6 We love pets! All breeds are welcome, but ANY dog displaying aggressive behavior will be served an eviction notice that will also apply to its owners. All dogs must be under visual control and visual observation of their owner at all times. We love pet owners who use a 6' maximum leash and use the designated areas to exercise them. Please keep them quiet, do not leave them unattended, and pick up after them both on and off your site. Free waste bags are available throughout the park. Pets are not allowed in the restrooms, laundry room, playground, or swimming pool area.
- 7 We know a 5½ mile per hour speed limit is odd, but we hope it is memorable. Please be careful of the children!
- 8 Do you want to see a propane tank explode or a fur baby freak out? We don't either. NO FIREWORKS, PLEASE!
- 9 It's awesome that you've brought your golf cart, mini bike, or other motorized "thing" but, due to past issues, we do not allow them in our park.
- 10 We try to keep our grass green, so please do not park between sites. We have lots of expensive gravel for you to park on. Extra parking is available at the office. We know Camping World told you their mat would let the grass "breathe" but they lied. No mats on the grass and no mats larger than 2x3 feet, please!
- 11 Please place trash at either end of your site. Garbage is picked up every day around 11:00 AM by the amazing KOA staff.
- 12 Our restrooms are cleaned between 11:00 AM and 12:00 PM every day. Small children should be accompanied by an adult to the restroom. Please do not wash your dishes in the restroom; there is a sink for this purpose at the rear of the building.
- 13 Thanks in advance for not smoking in or around any of our buildings. All playgrounds and the pool are also designated non-smoking areas.
- 14 Please do not leave campfires unattended, and do not move fire rings. Please avoid campfires during windy or extreme weather conditions, and do not discard ashes in trash or on the grass. Please do not move firewood; buy it where you burn it.
- 15 Due to the fact that Miles City receives enough precipitation already, please do not wash your RV, car, truck ... you get the idea.
- 16 No tents on RV sites, please! We have plenty of sites that are designated for tents.
- 17 This is a privately owned property. We reserve the right to remove any individual whose conduct or language is disruptive to others or anyone who is breaking the policies of the campground.

## Local Restaurants

## Local Attractions

**Waterworks Museum:** Open since 1977, overlooks the Yellowstone River. It is housed in the concrete basins of the 1910 WaterWorks that produced Miles City's drinking water for over 60 years. A local must see attraction.
